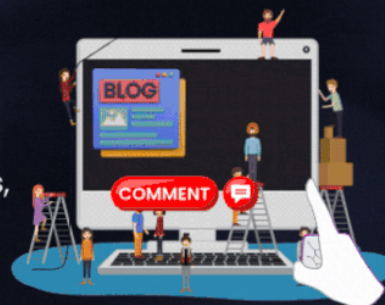

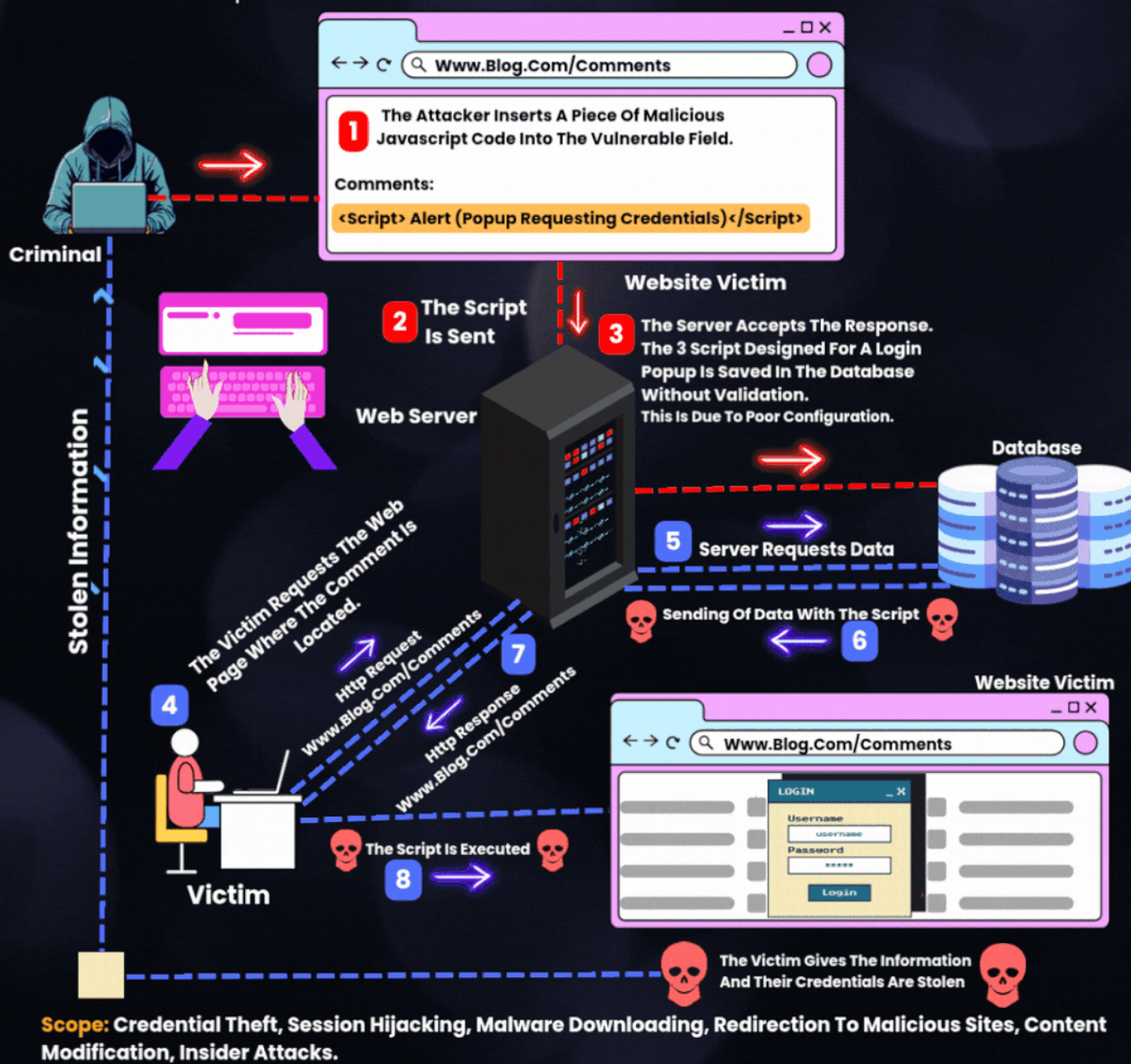
Cross-Site Scripting (XSS) Is A Web Vulnerability That Allows Attackers To Execute Malicious Code On Websites Visited By Other Users, Which Can Result In Data Theft And Unauthorized Session Control.

Stored XSS (Persistent XSS)

First The Attacker Finds An Entry Point Into A Web Application That Allows Users To Enter Data That Is Displayed To Other Users. This Could Be In Areas Such As Comments, User Profiles, Forum Posts, Etc.
