

1. Reset everything: if you have this kind of message:

```
error: key "A6234074498E9CEE" could not be looked up remotely
```

here's the Hiroshima™ ® © solution

```
# rm -R /etc/pacman.d/gnupg/  
# rm -R /root/.gnupg/ # only if the directory exists  
# gpg --refresh-keys  
# pacman-key --init && pacman-key --populate  
# pacman-key --refresh-keys
```

2. Reset a key: example repo-ck (as root)

```
pacman-key -r 5EE46C4C && pacman-key --lsign-key 5EE46C4C
```

Garuda

→ Garuda Assistant > Refresh Keyring

Archlinux

```
sudo pacman -Sy archlinux-keyring  
sudo pacman-key --populate archlinux  
sudo pacman-key --refresh-keys  
sudo pacman -Syu
```

or

```
killall gpg-agent  
rm -rf /etc/pacman.d/gnupg  
pacman-key --init  
pacman-key --populate archlinux
```
